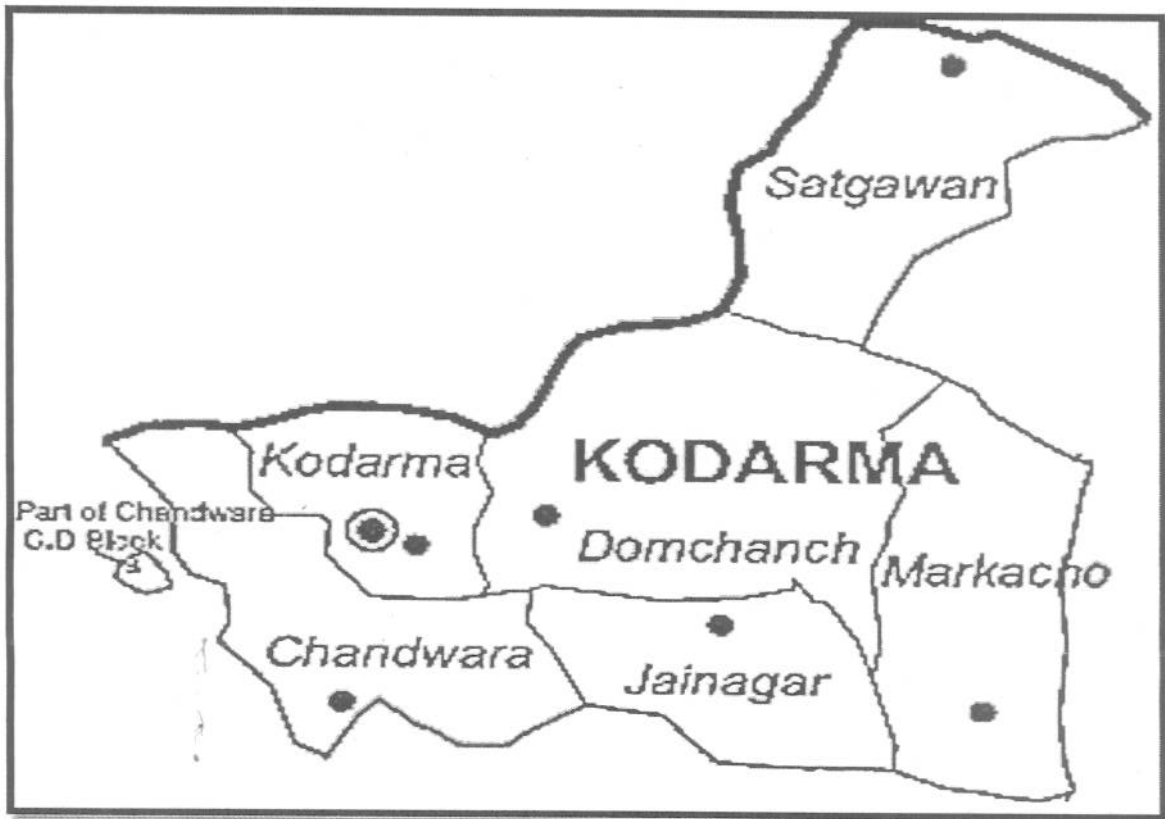


Kodarma District Profile



Koderma district ranks twenty-first in terms of total population in the state and first in regard to decadal population growth rate (2001-11) among the twenty-four districts. With a sex ratio of 950, it ranks thirteenth in the state. The district comprises of six blocks namely, Satgawan, Koderma, Domchanch, Jainagar, Chandwara and Markacho. As per Census 2011, the district has 577 villages and 5 towns distributed in one assembly constituency. Census 2011 figures indicated that the percentage share of scheduled caste population to total population was 15.22 percent while that of scheduled tribes was 0.96 percent. Based on the number of total rural households in Census 2011 and BPL Revision Survey of 2010-11 the percentage of BPL households in rural areas is 64.22 percent.
